All parents/carers of pupils in KS2 are invited to join us on Friday 31st March

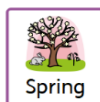


Bluebell Walk

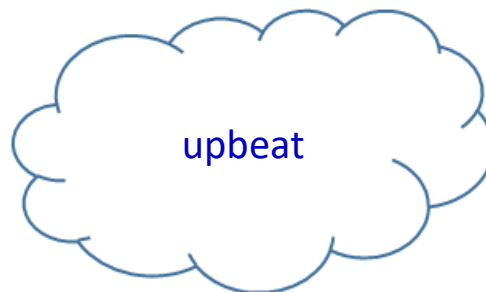
Please feel free to drop-in during the above times to discuss any concerns you have about your child's educational needs.
