Year 2 Cricket Tournament

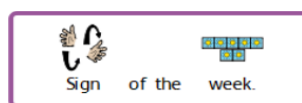

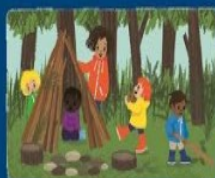
