uniform on this day.

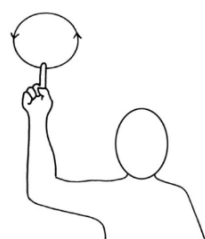
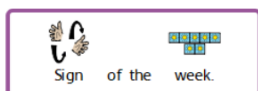
For Nursery and Pre-School children, if this is a day

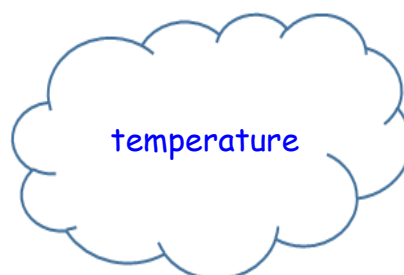


### Closing the Word Gap!
