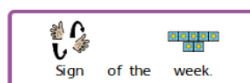

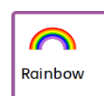

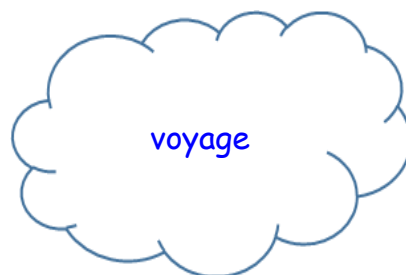


### Closing the Word Gap!
