### Transition Morning

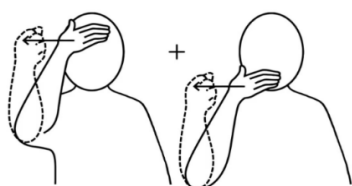
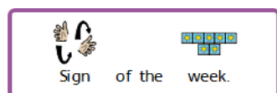
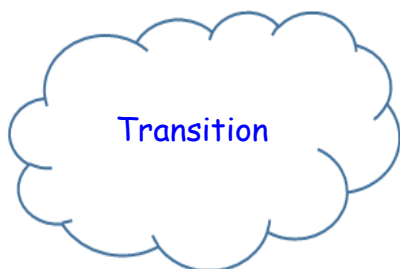
Children will spend the morning with their new
