Never give up, Encourage others, and Do your best.

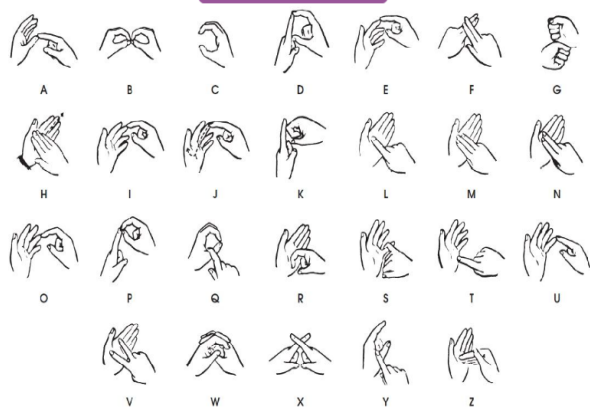


SEND Drop-in
