We are more than happy for children to use the gym and play equipment on the playground at the end of the day, but after school your children are your responsibility and must be observed at all times.



Sadly, some forest school equipment, including our new weather station, have been broken.

Children are not to play in this area after school, even with Parent/Carer Supervision.


