The closing date for making an application is 31st October 2023.

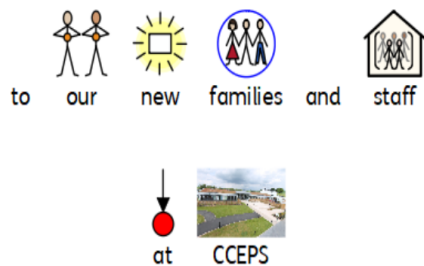

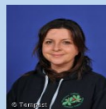
