Dear Parents / Carers

On Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October, Year 1 and Year 2 will be visiting the National Sea Life Centre in Birmingham. The children's topic this term is 'the dangers and delights of the sea' so the visit will fit in perfectly.

In science, the children have been learning about sea creatures and their environment, including how they adapt to their surroundings. The children have also been creating descriptive writing about the sea and the creatures. The educational visit will allow the children to have first-hand experiences of different sea creatures and learning new information, and will inspire them when back in the classroom to create longer pieces of writing, pretending we are deep sea divers.

After the visit, the children will also have chance to create their own aquarium in Design & Technology.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 9.30am and anticipate being back before the end of the normal school day.

The children need to be dressed in their school uniform and will be provided with a packed lunch from Shire Services, which will consist of a sandwich, cookie, piece of fruit and a drink.

The cost of the trip will be £12.00 per child, which includes transport and entrance fee.
