Ŏ	Go round the apple, down and flick.

	Start at the top and curl around the string of sausages
N	to the end.
	Go down the tiger's back, curl round his tail
	and put his arms on.
ſ	Start at the top, go down around the bottom of the
	umbrella, back up, down and flick.
	Start at Val's shoulder, down to her elbow and
	back up to her violin.
	Go over the stormy waves: down, up, down, up.
X××	Go down this way and that way, like a kiss.
R	Go down and around, down the yoyo's string
	and add a curl.
Z	Go across the road, zigzag down and across to the zoo.
