Agenda

- 1. Story with Santa idea:

- 2. Decorate Baubles
 - All craft-based ideas will be omitted, as the classes are already doing this.
- 3. Christmas Jumper day
 - This will be run at £1.50 per child. Dates TBC.
- 4. Guess the teachers in the Santa Mask.
 - The group agreed to move ahead with this
 - Oli to photoshop pictures of teachers dressed as Santa
- 5. Christmas Landmarks Quiz
 - o £1.50 will be charged per entry
 - Sheets will be sent home via book bags
 - Catriona Cork will do Santa Landmarks
 - o Quiz with answers dotted around school may be a good idea
- 6. Advent Door Prize door (Daily raffle)
 - o Raffle prize every day: '12 days of Christmas Bottles Raffle'
 - Prizes to be distributed in a COVID-secure method (TBD)
 - £1 per ticket for entry to all draws TBC
 - One code for each draw
- 7. Christmas Home Bake Off
 - Send in photos to be judged.
 - o May struggle with events that require participation at home
- 8. Christmas Bingo
 - Could be run as a stand along event. The group agreed to revisit this in February via
 Zoom.
- 9. Christmas Pet Show
 - Participants can send in pictures of their pets for the festive season: 'Chaddesley Cor-'Pet' Competition'
 - Winner gets best in show
 - Nicky to create certificates
- 10. Santa's Passport
 - o Running the distance to where Santa lives as a sponsored run event.

- o £1 entry and sponsorship on top of that
- The group agreed that this could be linked to Sports Day next year. Might be the wrong temperature for an outdoor event and time of year to get sponsorship
- 11. Set-up a Santa letter box and children receive a response
 - Writing task to school per class, and teacher can read out the reply. The group agreed that this would be a good to justify why they want a particular gift.
 - o Postal fee to be decided if not already being done as a school exercise
 - o Could sync it up when we have 'Story with Santa' to avoid postage
