## Top Tips

The secret to successfully embedding knowledge is practising it little and often. Regularly return to the skills and incorporate into simple games and other activities.

Ideas:

- Singing songs such as 5 speckled frogs, 5 current buns, 5 little men, 5 little ducks etc.
- Use practical objects and play games to help embed these skills. E.g. Play Bunny Ears. Using 2 hands to be the ears, how many ways can you show 3 ?
- Online resources such as - https://toytheater.com/two-color-counter-five-frame/ Use two different counters to represent 5 .
- Pairs game - write the numbers $0,1,2,3,4,5$ each on their own sheet of paper or card and turn them upside down. Children turn over cards and see if the pair of numbers make 5.
- Write numerals on the ground with chunky chalk and ask you child to stand on a number. They are then to jump to another number so the two number total 5 .
