### Home learning

The expectation is that children can access home learning when they are isolating. Children who are not in school because they are unwell (self-isolating or not) will not be expected to do any home learning.

*Children may be isolating for many reasons:*

Reason **A** – Child is isolating due to family member having a positive test (14 days)

Reason **B** – Class bubble from school is closed due to a member of the class having had a positive test (14 days)

Reason **C** – Child at home awaiting results from a test – return to school if negative – if positive remain at home for 10 days

Reason **D** – Child is having to quarantine - will only apply to children who were away in another country during the school holidays but guidance changed while they were away.

Reason **E** – Advice from doctors is that the child shield due to health vulnerabilities

Reason **F** – Child is isolating due to family member awaiting a result from a test – if result is negative return to school, if positive then reason A applies.

If your child is isolating for reason **A or E** they will be emailed the home learning overview along with their class teacher's email so they can contact them with any worries or concerns. Please forward any photos or work to the class teacher for feedback. The teacher will aim to respond to any emails within 24 hours as they will still be in school teaching. The class teacher will also phone the pupil for a wellbeing chat weekly.

If you child is isolating for reason **B** they will be emailed the home learning overview along with their class teacher's email so they can contact them with any worries or concerns. . Please forward any photos or work to the class teacher for feedback. The teacher will respond to any emails within the school day as they will isolating as well. The class teacher will do a daily zoom session, parents will be emailed the passwords and ID at 9am for a 9.30am ZOOM, where possible these will be live sessions with the class teacher but if circumstances do not allow it will be another member of staff. The class teacher will also phone the pupil for a wellbeing chat weekly.

If your child is isolating for reason **C,D or F** they will be emailed the home learning overview along with their class teacher's email so they can contact them with any worries or concerns. Please forward any photos or work to the class teacher for feedback. The teacher will aim to respond to any emails within 24 hours as they will still be in school teaching.

The daily zoom sessions is available for whole classes who are having to isolate, it is not essential that you attend. These will be led by the teachers who normally support in them in school as they will also be isolating. The zoom sessions will *not* be a virtual lesson they will be an outline of the home learning for day from the overview, discuss work completed on the previous day and a well- being catch up.

### **Zoom etiquette**

- You will receive the meetings ID and passcode at 9am before the zoom session starts at 9.30am.
- No 1:1 sessions will take place only class groups
- Staff and children must wear suitable clothing, as should anyone else in the household
- Any computers used should be in appropriate areas, for example, not in bedrooms; and where possible be against a neutral background
- Language must be professional and appropriate, including any family members in the background
- Videos may be muted for both pupils and staff if other children in the household become unsettled or cause a disruption.
- The sessions will last for approximately 20 minutes
- All zoom sessions will be recorded for safeguarding reasons.
- When the children log on they will have a couple of minutes to say hello to their friends and the teacher will mute them all when the session begins.
