



Choose a recipe, gather the necessary ingredients, and prepare the dish with the help of their families. Write a brief reflection on your cooking experience, including what they learned about African cuisine and any challenges they encountered.</p> 	<p><u>African Music Playlist:</u> Research and create a playlist of African music featuring songs from different African countries and genres. Create a PowerPoint to share your findings.</p>
