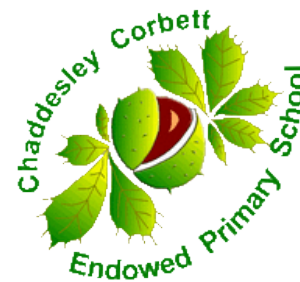


Key Instant Recall Facts

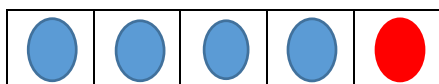
Year 1 – Autumn 1



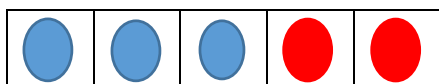
I can recall number bonds up to 5.

Number bonds up to 5 – Adding two numbers together to make all numbers up to 5.

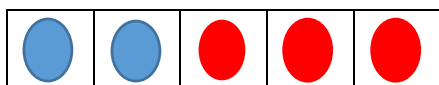
Children should be able to recall number bonds up to 2, 3, 4 and 5.



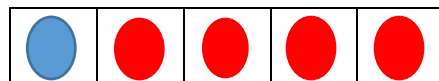
$$4 + 1 = 5$$



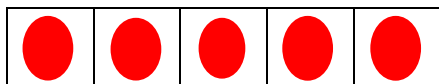
$$3 + 2 = 5$$



$$2 + 3 = 5$$

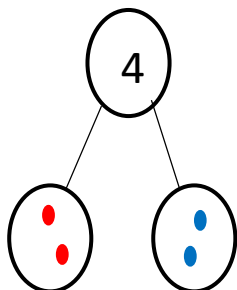


$$1 + 4 = 5$$



$$0 + 5 = 5$$

Children should know the five frame shows $2 + 2 = 4$ without counting.



Using the part-whole model, Children should know that the two parts make the whole number.

Top Tips

The secret to successfully embedding knowledge is practising it **little** and **often**. Regularly return to the skills and incorporate into simple games and other activities.

Ideas:

- Use practical objects and play games to help embed these skills. E.g. Play Bunny Ears. Using 2 hands to be the ears, how many ways can you show 5?
- Singing songs e.g. 5 little speckled frogs.
